

Local 113: Job cuts feared if Bombardier gets transit work

TORONTO – the TTC has announced plans to outsource some work in a proposed \$42 million contract to Bombardier Transportation.

Bob Kinnear, president of Amalgamated Transit Union Local 113, said Bombardier will take away work done by his members, such as maintaining or removing streetcar doors, windshield wipers and the metal poles inside the car.

"The work they're planning on contracting out is work that our members have done in the past and continue to do," said Kinnear, who plans to ask the transit commission at its meeting today to defer a decision until the union knows more about the proposed deal.
